

THE AMERICAN COLLEGE OF ST. AUGUSTINE HOLDS A MEETING AT CENER

Sarriguren (Navarra), 16 December 2010.- Representatives from wind sector companies, such as Ingeteam, Acciona Energia, Gamesa or M. Torres have met this morning at the headquarters of the National Energy Centre (CENER) to study the existing collaboration possibilities with the St. Augustine College of Chicago.

Andrew Sund (President), Norman Ruano (Vice-president) and David Sanchez (Business Development Manager) were responsible for presenting the activities of the first bilingual (dual-language) institution of higher education to be authorised by the Government of Illinois, which is specialised in renewable energy education. In the specific case of their visit to Spain, the main objective was to facilitate contacts with major Spanish companies and institutions from the renewable energy sector that operate in the United States. The college of St. Augustine has a permanent training and education structure in areas related to bilingual training in this sector, and it seeks to explore collaboration possibilities for its sustainability and renewable energy centre.

This presentation that has taken place at CENER has been organised by the Carolina Foundation, dependent upon the Ministry for Foreign Affairs and Collaboration whose aim is to promote cultural relations and cooperation in educational and scientific fields between Spain and the countries of the Ibero-american Community of Nations, as well as with other countries that have special historical links and a strong Hispanic presence.

After the conference, the representatives of the college and of the Carolina Foundation visited CENER laboratories and held a meeting with the Regional Minister of Innovation, Enterprise and Employment of the Government of Navarra, the Director General of CENER, Jose Javier Armendariz, and the Technical Director, Fernando Sanchez Sudon. From the Carolina Foundation, the representatives at the meeting were Gustavo Rovira and Ines Perez de Rada.
